The role of the the Independent Commission on Civil Aviation Noise (ICCAN) is to act as a credible and authoritative voice on civil aviation noise issues. ICCAN began work in January 2019.

Over the coming months ICCAN will be engaging with communities, the aviation industry, government and other bodies in the aviation sector to understand the current debates and issues around aviation noise. Based on that engagement, and the role envisaged for it by the government's [2017 Airspace Policy Consultation response](#), ICCAN will build a programme of activity that it will publish in the spring of 2019.

The government has committed to review the work of ICCAN within 2 years, including further consideration on whether to grant ICCAN statutory powers for enforcement of noise impact policies.

ICCAN is chaired by Robert Light and is in the process of appointing a board of commissioners. They will be supported by a small secretariat.
