Your council may have engaged in this Gatwick Airport process. You may have, like so many other stakeholders, been very concerned by the lack of clear maps to aid commenting on the methodology being used by the Gatwick consultants.

We urge your council to write to Gatwick Airport - IGWairspace.FASIS@gatwickairport.com - raising concern that as a stakeholder it is near impossible to comment on the methodology or routes removed when there is a lack of clear information and diagrams.

We offer a standard letter here for you to consider sending from your council to Gatwick copying in your councillors and Member of Parliament as the CAP 1616 process that Gatwick is using to engage is formed by a government body, the Civil Aviation Authority.

Dear Gatwick Airport FASIS process

XXXXXXXXXXXX Council write with concern to the FASIS process being undertaken by the Gatwick Airport consultants. It lacks clear information for our council, as a stakeholder, to be able to respond in an informed manner.

We find that the methodology that you seek comments on has become far too complex. The diagrams and mapping used, only as examples, actively prevents a clear understanding of what is being requested in feedback.

We do not believe that Gatwick Airport should be permitted to move forward in the Civil Aviation Authorities CAP1616 consultation process as we, as a stakeholder, find it

impossible to comment on behalf of our residents to what the benefits or negatives are being offered through this proposed methodology.

We ask that this stage of the CAP1616 process be repeated with clear diagrams that identify locations, existing routings of flight paths, and how the proposed methodology will impact this.

We do not believe the Gatwick Airport should be permitted to go forward by the CAA due this lack of transparency to what is being proposed.

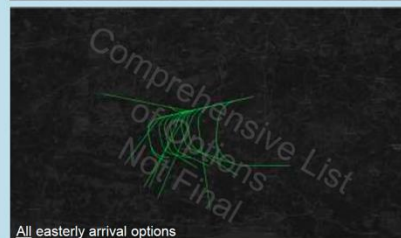
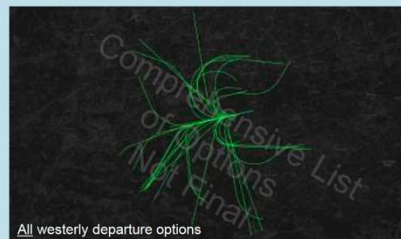
