Noise Management Board

Reduce Night Noise Trail starts 28th December to remove the outlier arriving aircraft to reduce noise. This should benefit those further away from the airport. It will end 28th June unless the trial is deemed to not be reducing noise, i.e. no benefits. This will be for planes 6,000ft and below. Schemes like this are already conducted at night at Schiphol and JFK to reduce noise

There are not that many flights during the early hours according to Gatwick, so the trial should not be noticed by residents but they will be PRNAV routes (concentrated routes).
