CAGNE prepares for the next stage of the DCO to obtain a new runway by Gatwick Airport. Be prepared for the announcements by the Secretary of State (SoS) for Transport on 27th February next year and what action we should then mount. [Read more here](#)

The DCO hearings cost just over £70,000 as our legal team pushed Gatwick at every step, so we required additional qualified expert reports to counter the Gatwick half-truths.

CAGNE seeks a cross-party letter to the Secretary of State for Transport led by Andrew Griffith MP. This succeeded in a letter from Tom Tugendhat, Mims Davies and Andrew. It also succeeded in the LibDems of which there are 5 surrounding Gatwick to send a letter of objection to a new runway to the SoS. Delighted that Caroline Lucas replacement Sian Berry was keen to sign.
